What is Family Treatment Court?

- ◆ FTC is a voluntary program that follows a drug court model. It provides support and accountability to parents during their substance abuse treatment to increase success in sobriety. The mission of Family Treatment Court is to assist parents involved in the child welfare system toward achieving and maintaining sobriety, promote family reunification and improve well-being for children and families.

Who is eligible?

- ◆ Have an open dependency in Maricopa County
- ◆ Have a history of substance abuse
- ◆ Willing to consistently participate in substance abuse treatment.
- ◆ Must not have a severance trial scheduled within a month of observing
- ◆ Must not have a criminal case pending that is connected to dependency
