What We Do

- Provide Adult Sexual Assault Investigation training throughout Arizona for law enforcement and other criminal justice professionals
- All training is free and is currently offered in-person
- Utilize Coordinated Community Response Guidelines
- All trainers are subject matter experts
- 11 courses with current AZPOST approval
 - Remaining courses likely eligible for AZPOST credit

Who We Have Trained

2022-3 Contract Year

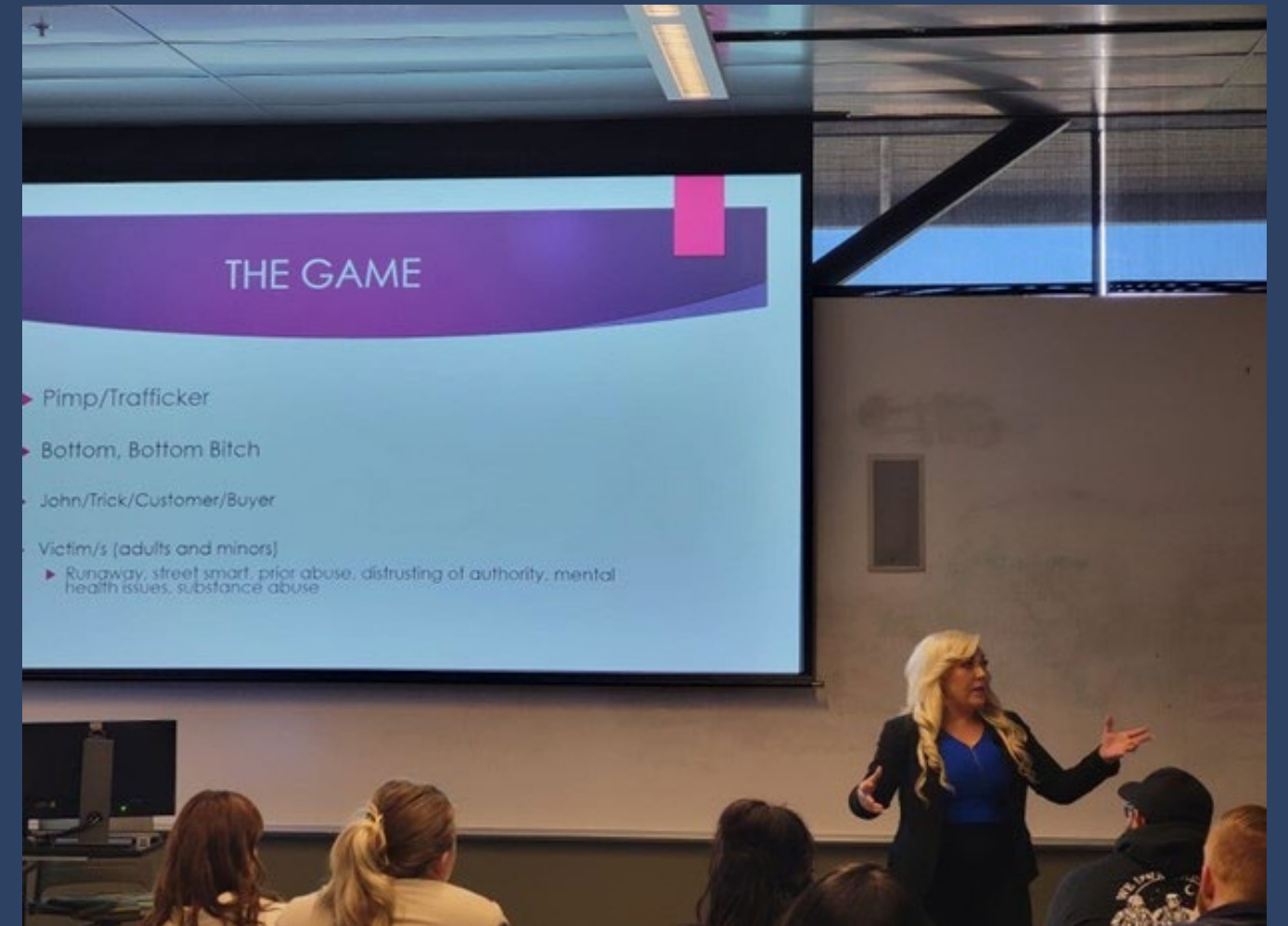
- 14 training events in 4 Counties
- 377 individuals trained:
 - 244 Law Enforcement
 - 44 different agencies from 9 Counties
 - 30 Prosecutors from 6 Counties
 - 38 Advocates
 - Other partners: Probation, FNE, Crisis Response



Total Trained

Contract start July 2019:

- Trained 1,097 individuals
- Approximately 75% are law enforcement
- Provided in-person training in 8 Counties



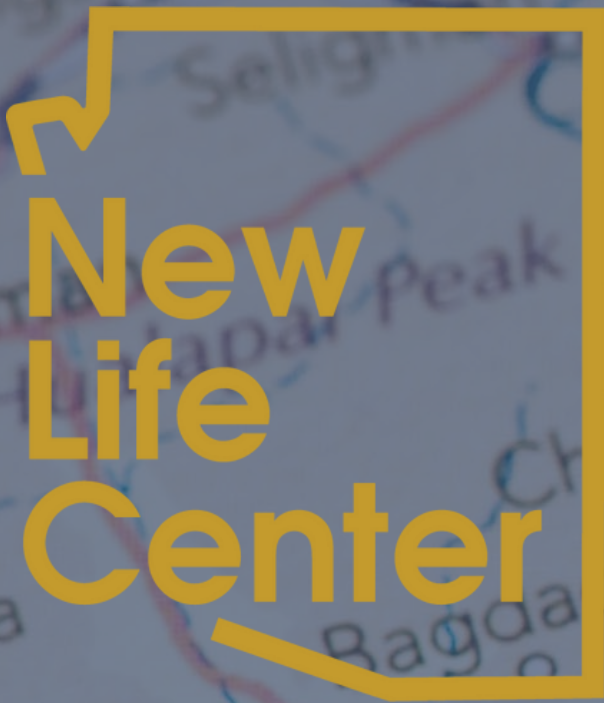
What Has Changed

- Started with 10 training topics
- Increased topics based on changing demands in the field
- New topics include:
 - Alcohol/Drug Facilitated Sexual Assault
 - DNA and Sexual Assault
 - Interviewing those with Developmental Disabilities
 - Search Warrants in Sexual Assault Cases

What's Next

- September 20th, Maricopa County
 - Interviewing Victims and Trauma Response
- October 26th, Maricopa County
 - Alcohol/Drug Facilitated Sexual Assault
- Schedule pending training requests
- Working on internal registration platform
