

Vision: Families have what they need, when they need it.




What **problem** are we trying to solve?

Families are overwhelmed and under-resourced.

- **Providers** don't know where to refer families
- Families don't know where to access resources
- Overreliance on the Department of Child Safety
- Isolated attempts to coordinate
- Inefficient dissemination of resources to those in need

Solution:

Create a "hub and spoke" statewide system of family support founded on Family Resource Centers.



Family Resource Centers (FRCs)

Welcoming community hubs where families can access formal and informal supports, both in times of need and as a part of regular day-to-day life.

FRCs:

- are place-based
- offer information, resources, and referrals
- offer parenting support
- provide opportunities for families to build social connections



Why focus on FRCs?

- FRCs are hubs they simplify resource navigation
- FRCs are **community-based**, and **responsive** to the needs of families.
- FRCs are designed to be **universal** because every family needs support sometimes.

What outcomes do FRCs achieve?

According to studies conducted in other states, FRCs produce:

- \$4.93 social return on investment for every dollar invested
- \$3.65 in savings for the child welfare system for every dollar invested
- 63% reduction in child abuse cases
- 50% reduction of placements of children in foster care
- 26% lower rates of community-level child abuse investigations









Impact


Current Arizona Landscape
